 - I. *Resolution Approving an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement Between the Village of Bensenville and Bensenville Elementary School District No. 2 Regarding the Stormwater Management at Tioga School*

This item is an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with School District 2 regarding storm water management at Tioga School. For the past six months the Village has worked with District 2 to include an additional 2 acre feet storage basin as they construct Tioga School and the adjacent storm water management area. The intent of the additional storage is to help relieve flooding issues on the 200 block of Center and Addison Streets. Per the IGA, the Village would have until September 15, 2013 to construct the basin - all at our own expense. Staff recommends approval of this IGA, and the subsequent agenda item approves the construction contract for the work.
 2. *Resolution Authorizing the Execution of a Construction Contract for the Tioga Storm Water Detention Facility with A-Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc., of Schaumburg, IL in the amount of \$40,000.00*

This item follows the previous Intergovernmental Agreement with School District 2 to allow the Village of Bensenville to construct a 2 acre foot storm water basin at Tioga School for the purpose of helping relieve the chronic flooding at the 200 block of Center and Addison Streets. After working all summer to secure the most competitive bids for the construction, staff recommends contracting with A-Lamp for \$40,000. A-Lamp was able

to provide the most competitive price by far due to the fact that they need the dirt for the embankment work at the Irving Park Road and York Road grade separation project. All in (including soils testing, construction prep, and as-built drawings) the project will cost \$54,000, which will be funded through the CIP budget for land acquisition related to flooding mitigation. This item appears directly in front of the Board due to the time constraint of having to be concluded with construction by September 15, 2013. Staff recommends approval.

1. Village Information Technology Services:

A) Ordinance Establishing the Position of Village Chief Technology Office and Eliminating the Position of Village Director of Administrative Services; and B) Resolution Approving the Engagement of PC Discovery for Information Technology Support and Operations Services.

Over the past year the Village benefited from the Baecore Group acting as our CTO and PC Discovery acting as our IT support and operations consultant. However, the 2013 Budget envisioned upgrading to an internal CTO, which would become a key member of the Village Leadership Team. Hiring of this CTO position requires a text amendment to officially create the position in the Village Code, therefore this agenda item presents an Ordinance doing so. In addition, staff recommends extending our contract with PC Discovery for 5 months until December 31, 2013. PC Discovery would be managed by the CTO and provide backup and continued IT support to the Village. Once the CTO is brought on staff, the IT support for the Village in 2014 and beyond will be determined in the 2014 Budget. The salary range for the CTO is \$84,000 - \$105,000 and the 5-month contract with PC Discovery is \$34,571.25. Staff recommends approval of the Ordinance and Resolution.

This agenda item determines wages for the Village's AFSCME bargaining unit that represents 28 full time and 2 part time public works and clerical employees. The current contract that was adopted in 2011 is valid until 2015, however wages for the final two years were not agreed upon in 2011 and dialogue was set to be reopened related to wages in 2013. The union and management began negotiations earlier this year and came to agreement on 2.25% wage adjustments retroactive to May 1, 2013 and for May 1, 2014. In addition 3 clerical employees at the top of their range will receive \$500 signing bonuses. These negotiations were conducted in good faith and both sides have agreed to these wages. Staff recommends approval.



BACKGROUND:

Over the past six months, staff has been working with School District 2 to put together a plan that would allow for the construction of a 2.0 acre-foot detention basin at the Tioga School Site. The District is currently reconfiguring this site with new school buildings that offer the opportunity for the Village to construct this basin to assist in reducing chronic flooding downstream along the 200 blocks of Center and Addison.

KEY ISSUES:

Terms have been set and a formal Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) has been drafted between the Village and the School District. A copy is included in the packet.

Basic highlights from the IGA include the following:

1. The Village will be allowed to construct a 2.0 acre-foot detention basin on the Tioga site by excavating approximately 9,000 cubic yards of soil.
2. The Village will have until September 15, 2013 to construct the facility and leave the District a site ready for seeding and landscaping.
3. The Village will pay for all costs associated with the construction of the facility.
4. The Village will have use of the facility for a minimum of 10 years.
5. In the event the District experience growth in enrollment or programs that will require the use of the land on which the facility resides, the District must provide a minimum 2 year notice to the Village.
6. The Village will retain all necessary permits for the project.
7. The District will provide temporary easements for the construction and ongoing maintenance of the expanded portion of the detention basin.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the Resolution

BUDGET IMPACT:

This item was discussed shortly after the CY2013 budget was approved. Therefore no funds were specifically allocated for this project. However, \$400,000 was allocated for property acquisition on the 200 block of Center for the purpose of storm water improvements. This project would fit into the overall goal of that item. Total project costs are estimated to be approximately \$54,000 (\$9,000 soil testing, \$5,000 construction staking and as built drawings, \$40,000 construction).

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BENSENVILLE
AND BENSENVILLE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2
REGARDING THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT
AT TIOGA SCHOOL**

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as the “IGA”) is made and entered into this ____ day of August, 2013, by and between the Village of Bensenville (hereinafter referred to as the “VILLAGE”) and Bensenville Elementary School District No. 2 (hereinafter referred to as the “DISTRICT”), hereinafter collectively referred to as the “PARTIES”:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE is a body corporate and politic organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois, located in the Counties of Cook and DuPage, State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT is a body corporate and politic, and a School District organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois, located in the County of DuPage, State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, each party herein is a unit of local government under Illinois Law; and

WHEREAS, Article 7, Section 10, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 authorizes and encourages cooperation between and among units of local government to obtain or share services, to contract with individuals, and to exercise and combine any power or function in any manner not prohibited by law or by ordinance, and further authorizes such cooperating units if local government to use their revenues and other resources to pay costs related to such intergovernmental activities; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE agrees to evaluate methods to engineer and improve the area surrounding TIOGA to eventually reduce or possibly eliminate the need for the enlarged capacity of the water detention basin at TIOGA; and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT is willing to permit the expansion of the existing water detention basin at TIOGA to accommodate said increase in compensable stormwater storage, provided the DISTRICT retains the right to require the relocation, modification or elimination of said water detention basin should the DISTRICT need the property currently encumbered by the water detention basin where the additional compensable storage is contemplated, for future expansion of DISTRICT operations; and

WHEREAS, the PARTIES recognize that this agreement between the VILLAGE and the DISTRICT will have a beneficial and positive effect on the VILLAGE and the DISTRICT and their respective residents; and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT and the VILLAGE have engaged in discussions to reach this agreement to allow the VILLAGE to provide additional stormwater storage for the benefit of the VILLAGE and the DISTRICT, recognizing the value to both PARTIES of working together to for their respective and mutual benefit; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE and DISTRICT have determined that it is in the best interests of the VILLAGE and its residents and the DISTRICT and its residents, for the PARTIES to enter into this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the VILLAGE and the DISTRICT agree as follows:

1. Incorporation of Recitals

All recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated herein as though set forth in total.

2. Purpose

This IGA creates legal obligations on the part of the VILLAGE and the DISTRICT, which shall be further memorialized as necessary to effectuate the intent set forth herein. As the PARTIES continue to consult and work together, they may enter into one or more additional intergovernmental agreements, specifically outlining additional duties and obligations toward one another.

3. Responsibilities of the Parties

This paragraph sets forth the agreement of the PARTIES as to their respective duties and responsibilities to one another.

A. DISTRICT Authorizations and Agreements:

1. The DISTRICT hereby authorizes the VILLAGE to enlarge the capacity of the water detention basin at TIOGA by an additional two (2) acre feet of compensatory storage, by excavating and removing approximately 9,000 cubic yards of soil from the water detention basin at the TIOGA site, in order to reduce flooding to the property north of the School at or near Memorial Road.
2. The DISTRICT agrees that it shall be responsible for final grading and seeding of the expanded area of the water detention basin and the areas immediately adjacent thereto.
3. The DISTRICT hereby grants to the VILLAGE a temporary construction easement at the TIOGA site over the minimum area necessary for construction by the VILLAGE of the modifications to the existing water detention basin on the TIOGA Property for the duration of the Project.
4. The DISTRICT hereby grants to the VILLAGE a temporary maintenance and utility easement over the enlarged water detention basin on the TIOGA Property, permitting the VILLAGE to enter the TIOGA Property to maintain the expanded water detention basin until the reversion of the property as described herein.
5. The VILLAGE has provided draft drawings for the water detention basin work at the site (see Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference). Substantial variations from these drawings shall require further review and approval by the DISTRICT.

B. VILLAGE Obligations and Agreements:

1. The VILLAGE hereby agrees to construct or to cause to be constructed, two (2) acre feet of compensatory storage to enlarge the capacity of the water detention basin at TIOGA, by excavating and removing approximately 9,000 cubic yards of soil from the water detention basin at the TIOGA site, in order to reduce flooding to the property north of the School at or near Memorial Road. All costs associated with the Project shall be borne exclusively by the VILLAGE, including, without limitation, all costs of excavation, testing, and removal of the soil and other materials.
2. If the DISTRICT performs any additional work or incurs any costs in relation to the Project, including, without limitation, any costs of excavation, testing, removal of the soil and other materials, or repairs to the grounds adjacent to the

expanded portion of the water detention basin, or any increased charges from DISTRICT contractors resulting from the creation of the expanded detention, the VILLAGE agrees to reimburse, indemnify, and pay the DISTRICT or its contractor(s) for all such costs and all related expenses.

3. The VILLAGE hereby agrees to comply with the timelines set forth herein.
4. The VILLAGE hereby agrees to require all contractors performing work on the Project to carry liability and property damage insurance, with limits and insurance coverage acceptable to the DISTRICT, naming the Board of Education, its members, officers, employees, consultants and agents as additional insureds thereunder.
5. The VILLAGE hereby agrees to secure all required permits, at VILLAGE expense, before commencement of any work on the Project.
6. The VILLAGE hereby agrees to arrange for and obtain all required testing of the materials removed from the excavation of the two (2) additional acre feet from the water detention basin at TIOGA, with the cost of such testing to be borne exclusively by the VILLAGE.
7. The VILLAGE hereby agrees to transfer all materials removed from the excavation of the two (2) additional acre feet from the water detention basin at TIOGA to a site of the VILLAGE'S choosing, with the cost of such transfer to be borne exclusively by the VILLAGE.

4. Proposed Project Timeline

1. The VILLAGE shall not begin work on the Project until the DISTRICT agrees that all necessary insurance, permits and other documentation has been obtained and is acceptable to the DISTRICT.
2. The VILLAGE acknowledges that the DISTRICT needs to begin seeding and landscaping the site in September of 2013. Therefore, the VILLAGE agrees that all heavy equipment work shall be completed, the site shall be restored, and the site shall be turned over to the DISTRICT, fully ready for seeding and landscaping by September 15, 2013. If this date is not met, the VILLAGE shall pay to the DISTRICT all reasonable costs related to the delay beyond September 15 that the DISTRICT incurs.
3. The VILLAGE further agrees that the detention Project described in this IGA shall not impact nor impede the completion of the Phase II addition to Tioga School which is targeted for substantial completion in early summer of 2014. If the detention Project described in this IGA impedes the completion of the Phase II addition to Tioga School in any way, the DISTRICT shall have the right to halt the detention Project described in this IGA with no recourse from or further

obligation to the VILLAGE, at the VILLAGE's sole cost, until such time as the schedule conflict is resolved by the PARTIES.

4. The VILLAGE hereby agrees that it shall make the Project area accessible to the DISTRICT at all times. The DISTRICT and its Construction Manager, GILBANE BUILDING COMPANY, shall have the right to monitor all activities on the Project to make sure that the required work can be completed within the DISTRICT'S construction schedule, with no impact to the completion of the Phase II addition to Tioga School.
5. The VILLAGE hereby agrees that it shall be responsible for all damage to the grounds of the DISTRICT outside the Project area, and to the property and equipment of the DISTRICT and its contractors and vendors, caused by the VILLAGE or any of its contractors during the course of the Project.

5. Reversion of Property

In the event the DISTRICT experiences growth in enrollment or programs or other circumstances arise which involve another use for the TIOGA property, then the DISTRICT may reduce, eliminate, or otherwise change the expanded detention capacity in the water detention basin at TIOGA that is created pursuant to this IGA, with at least two (2) years' notice to the VILLAGE, effective no sooner than October 1, 2023.




WHEREAS the Village of Bensenville has experienced chronic flooding in the area near the 200 blocks of Center Street and Addison Street, and

WHEREAS it is a goal in the Village's Strategic Plan to relieve flooding in this area, and

WHEREAS School District 2 is currently reconfiguring the Tioga/Chippewa School site immediately south of the area, and

WHEREAS staff has identified the Tioga site as a location to construct a 2.0 acre-foot storm water detention facility, and

WHEREAS this basin is intended to capture storm drainage upstream of the flooding area and thus improve flooding in major storms, and

WHEREAS the School District is willing to provide us this opportunity to construct the storm water detention facility, and

WHEREAS the Village and the School District will enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) to formalize the terms of this project, and

WHEREAS the Village received proposals from contractors to construct this basin, and

WHEREAS A-Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. submitted the best proposal in the amount of \$40,000.

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bensenville, Counties of DuPage and Cook, Illinois as follows:

THAT the Village Board authorizes the execution of a construction contract for the Tioga Storm Water Detention Facility with A-Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. of Schaumburg, IL in the amount of \$40,000.00, and

THAT the Village Board authorizes the Village Manager to execute a purchase order and other associated documents necessary.

BACKGROUND:

On June 26, 2013 the Village approved Resolutions to contract with PC Discovery for IT support and operation services and with Baecore Group for Chief Technology Officer (CTO) services. PC Discovery's contract with the Village expires on August 9, 2013 and Baecore's CTO contract expires on August 14, 2013. In the meantime the Village Board approved the internal position of CTO in the 2013 Budget and recently reached a consensus to hire an internal CTO.

KEY ISSUES:

In order to hire the new internal CTO position, the Village Attorney recommends that the Bensenville Village Code be cleaned up to assign official duties to the position that are currently listed under the now defunct "Director of Administrative Services." The attached Ordinance makes those changes, and lists the CTO's duties as "responsible for the implementation, operation and supervision of the village's information technology systems."

As for the IT support and operations services, staff recommends extending our contract with PC Discovery for an additional 5 months, through December 31, 2013, to ease the transition to an internal CTO and to provide backup and assistance with the day-to-day upkeep of the Village's IT systems. Once the CTO is brought on staff, a recommendation would be made in the 2014 Budget on the best way to proceed with IT support and operations in 2014 and beyond.

ALTERNATIVES:

- Discretion of the Board.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends passing the Ordinance creating the position of CTO and passing the Resolution extending the contract with PC Discovery until December 31, 2013. PC Discovery has done an excellent job serving the Village's IT needs over the past year and staff recommends their continued engagement until a permanent solution is determined in the 2014 Budget.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The standard schedule of pay for the CTO is an annual salary range of \$83,950 - \$104,700. The 5 month contract with PC Discovery is valued at \$34,571.25.

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF
VILLAGE CHIEF TECHNOLOGY OFFICER AND ELIMINATING THE POSITION
OF VILLAGE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Bensenville (hereinafter the “Village”) is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board is authorized under the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/5-3-8, to establish and eliminate Village departments and positions therein and to approve a standard schedule of pay for employment positions with the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that in recent years, technology systems have advanced at a rapid pace such that the integration of the latest technology systems into the Village’s information technology framework requires increasing expertise and commitment; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that the efficient and skilled use of information technology systems is in the best interest of the citizens of the Village because such use enables the Village to operate in a more cost efficient manner and to operate in a manner that is more responsive to the citizens of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village does not have an established employment position within the Village solely dedicated to the implementation, operation and supervision of the Village’s information technology systems; and

WHEREAS, under the Village Code, the director of administrative services is responsible for the implementation, operation and supervision of the Village’s information technology systems, among other duties; and

WHEREAS, in recent years, the Village has not filled the position of director of administrative services and the functions of that position have been carried out by other positions within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village to eliminate the position of director of administrative services and to create the position of chief technology officer to better and more efficiently meet the needs of the Village's information technology systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bensenville, Counties of DuPage and Cook, Illinois, duly assembled at a regular meeting, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The recitals set above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION TWO: The Bensenville Village Code shall be amended by deleting Chapter 20, Title 1, in its entirety, and replacing it, in total, as follows:

Chapter 20: CHIEF TECHNOLOGY OFFICER

1-20-1: ESTABLISHED:

- A. Creation Of Position: There is hereby created the position of chief technology officer.
- B. Duties: The chief technology officer is responsible for the implementation, operation and supervision of the village's information technology systems.
- B. Appointment: The chief technology officer shall be appointed and/or removed by the village manager.

SECTION THREE: The standard schedule of pay for the chief technology officer shall be an annual salary of \$83,950.00 to \$104,700.00.

SECTION FOUR: The Village Manager or his designee is directed to amend the Village's organizational chart to reflect the establishment of the position of chief technology officer as established by this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: The Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the Village of Bensenville, and the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to attest to, the Proposal attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A," with such

additions and revisions thereto as the Village Attorney shall require.



Proposal

1. Summary


The Village of Bensenville has requested a proposal to provide IT services. This proposal addresses the Support and Operations roles as detailed in the methodology below. This proposal is based on a 5 month contract starting August 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013. The proposal objectives include:

- Replacement of Existing Outsource IT Services
- Cost Reduction
- Services Expansion
- Positioning for Long-Term
- Minimal Transition Impact

2. Approach and Methodology

Over the past few years the Village has continued to expand the reliance and use of technology throughout the Village. Systems that were previously paper-based are computerized. Individuals that never used a computer are required daily to utilize a computer to complete their job and there is more time-sensitive data that is reliant on the network.

Based on these changes in the Village and the direction the Village is continuing to maintain, PC Discovery is presenting the Village with an opportunity to expand the function and responsibilities of the IT department while reducing their annual costs. The approach we are recommending is to implement a multi-tiered solution in Bensenville. This would provide Bensenville the resources and knowledge that would typically require hiring three or more people. As the picture depicts below we are recommending a Technology Officer to provide strategy and oversight while the support solution will provide the day-to-day support. Additionally the support solution will provide the Village with 24/7/365 systems monitoring and proactive management.



3. Project Scope

Support & Operations – PC Discovery

This scope details the IT support for approximately 500 users using 126 workstations/laptops and 25 servers, this support will be 24 x 7 x 365. There will be one person on site full-time 3 days a week. Events that occur outside the on-site window or if the person is not able to handle calls in a timely matter, events will be handled by our Network Operations Center/Help Desk, located in Chicago.

- Coordinate with SQL support to resolve issues as necessary

Manage Switches and Internet Routers

- Monitor Routers and Switch for Performance
- Maintain Cisco IOS and Configurations

- Modify Firewall configurations as required
- Update Firewall IOS Quarterly
- Configuration, installation and support of additional Routers and Switches will be provided as part of the day to day support services as long as it can be completed within the time frame requested by the existing onsite contracted technicians.
- Quarterly perform vulnerability analysis on the WAN side of the network.

Configuration, installation and support of additional Routers and Switches will be provided as part of the day to day support services as long as it can be completed within the time frame requested by the existing onsite contracted technicians. Any additional resources required to meet increased time frames may be completed on a Time and Material Basis.

Monitoring

All desktop/laptops and servers will be monitored on a 24x7x365 basis to allow us the ability resolve some problems before they become more severe with potential system and resulting staff downtime.

Provide real time “telemetry” from each machine, watching for known problems and immediately alerting us of a problem. (e.g. hard drive space getting low, server goes offline, etc.)

Real time auditing of hardware and software, giving detailed or summary reports in real-time of what hardware or software is installed. These reports are very important during budgeting / auditing time.

Notification of software installation or removal which is useful for vulnerability analysis in order to pinpoint potential security changes/threats.

Staff Augmentation

Should there be a need for us to be on site outside of the assigned on-site resource schedule, please see chart at bottom of proposal for priority and the associated service response times.

Tiered Coverage

Our Tiered support structure provides for a complete 360 degrees of coverage.

Tier 1 – On Site

Tier 2 – Phone Support for times when Tier 1 is busy or involved in more complex projects

Tier 3 – Remote support for urgent or “necessary” off hours support

Tier 4 – 24x7x365 eyes on your systems . With our Network Operation Center (NOC) – we are able to remotely monitor, manage and patch all systems. We utilize a state of the art tool and are alerted to machine problems the moment there is a problem, allowing us to react in real-time. This tool also allows us to provide regular maintenance and security patching to each machine. Our NOC team will alert us of problems whenever they occur regardless of business hours and take the necessary action to resolve the problem.

Service Levels

Response time is very important in our industry and we run our business off the following chart for those incidents that happen outside the standard work hours or when a second person is required:

5. Pricing Structure

The total cost of the Support Services on an annual basis is \$ 34,571.25. This pricing schedule represents a 12 month contract with onsite support three (3) days a week.

Additional support days beyond three days can be purchased at a rate of \$840.00 per day or \$7,728.00 for a block of 10 ten (10) days representing an eight percent discount.

Monthly payments will be made to PC Discovery at the beginning of each month for the services to be provided during the month.

BACKGROUND:

The American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees AFL-CIO, Council 31 (AFSCME) represents 28 fulltime and 2 part time Village of Bensenville employees in Public Works (clerical employees, Custodian, and PW Technicians), and clerical employees in Finance and CED. Our current four-year contract with AFSCME extends from May 1, 2011 to April 30, 2015, however since wage increases for the final two years of the contract were not agreed upon, negotiations were reopened for the purpose of determining wage increases for the period of May 1, 2013 - April 30, 2014 (FY14) and May 1, 2014 – April 30, 2015 (FY15).

KEY ISSUES:

After negotiating in good faith, the two sides agreed on wages as set forth below;

- Wage increase of 2.25% effective retroactive to May 1, 2013;
- Wage increase of 2.25% effective May 1, 2014;
- One-time bonuses of \$500 to each of the three clerical employees that are currently at their top step;
- The three full time and one part time Police Records Clerks are allowed into the union at the step closest to their current wage rate following ratification of the contract; and
- The two sides agree to schedule meeting on a career ladder program on or before September 13.

The career ladder meeting has since been scheduled for August 13, 2013.

The cost of the salary increases is \$54,340 in 2013/2014.

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A LABOR-MANAGEMENT UNION WAGE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BENSENVILLE AND
AFSCME LOCAL 1167 FOR 2013-2015**

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE OF BENSENVILLE (hereinafter “VILLAGE”) is a municipal corporation established and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, following good faith negotiations by the Parties, this Agreement is entered into between the VILLAGE OF BENSENVILLE, ILLINOIS (“Village”) AND AFSCME, COUNCIL 31 (“AFSCME”); and

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement between the Parties dated May 1, 2011 through April 30, 2015 (the “CBA”) will remain in full effect, except as stated in this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Article XI, Section 11.1 of the CBA will be revised to delete the wage re-opener provision for 2013 and 2014 and replace it with a 2.25% across the board increase in base wage rates retroactive to May 1, 2013 for all bargaining unit employees who were actively employed as of the ratification date of this Agreement. Additionally, effective May 1, 2014, all actively employed employees will receive a 2.25% increase in base wage rates; and

WHEREAS, the three (3) bargaining unit employees who are both: (a) in Step K, and (b) in the job classification of “account clerk II” or “secretary II”, will receive a one-time lump signing bonus equal to five hundred dollars and no cents (\$500) minus legally required payroll deductions. This lump sum bonus will be paid to the three affected employees on the date that the retroactive adjustment in wages is paid pursuant to the paragraph above; and

WHEREAS, the employees presently affected by the pending representation petition that AFSCME filed with the Illinois State Labor Relations Board affecting the employees who perform services within the Police Department in the job classification(s) of either records clerk

or investigative aide, will be added to the bargaining unit which is currently certified and covered by the CBA. Provided this Tentative Agreement is ratified by both parties on or before August 13, 2013, the Village agrees to voluntarily recognize their inclusion into the bargaining unit. As such, those four (4) employees, once certified by the ISLRB, will receive the 2.25% increase in their base wage rate as provided in the paragraph above and applicable to the other bargaining unit employees retroactive to May 1, 2013. Additionally, effective May 1, 2014, those four employees will be eligible for Pay Grade 1, Step D wage adjustments subject to the remaining provisions of the CBA.

WHEREAS, on or before September 13, 2013, the parties mutually agree to hold and participate in a meaningful discussion concerning the career ladder program as stated in the Side Letter of the underlying CBA; and

WHEREAS, AFSCME and its bargaining unit ratified this Agreement on July 30, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bensenville, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if fully set forth.

SECTION TWO: The Agreement attached as "Exhibit A" is hereby approved.

SECTION THREE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
