**MINUTES OF THE O'HARE IMPACT COMMITTEE MEETING  
October 14, 2014**

**CALL TO ORDER:** Trustee Ridder called the meeting to order at 7:38 p.m.

**PRESENT:** Upon roll call by Deputy Village Clerk, Corey Williamsen, the following Board Members were present:

Minutes:**

The September 9, 2014 O'Hare Impact Committee Minutes were presented.

**Motion:** Trustee Wessler made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Trustee O'Connell seconded the motion.

All were in favor. Motion carried.

**Informational  
Items:**

Village Manager, Michael Cassady, reviewed the Village's efforts within the last month. Mr. Cassady stated over the past month the Village has been working collaboratively with neighboring communities around O'Hare on a joint strategy to mitigate the airport impacts. Mr. Cassady stated the communities are considering the following strategic action plan:

- Lobby the City of Chicago and ONCC to formally request the FAA update the O'Hare Part 150 Noise Compatibility Plan (last version from 1989).

- Lobby the General Assembly to adopt the CNEL (Community Noise Equivalent Level) noise measurement method.
- Lobby Congress to direct the City of Chicago to amend the "Fly Quiet Program" to include incentives to follow and penalties when violated.
- The coalition of communities should travel together to Washington DC to meet with our local Congressional Delegation and the FAA.
- Runway 9 Center/27 Center should be constructed as soon as possible.
- Noise monitoring should be considered on a local and/or regional basis.

Mr. Cassady stated the Village attended two Suburban O'Hare Commission (SOC) meetings since the last Committee report. Mr. Cassady stated the Mayors participating in SOC asked community managers to meet to discuss possible strategies to gain relief from O'Hare noise. Mr. Cassady stated he met with Chicago Department of Aviation (CDA) officials to discuss the Village's request for additional noise monitor(s) and also to determine anticipated use of Runway 10R/28L (south runway). Mr. Cassady stated it appears that this runway will not be used for approach landings when in east flow, but will be used in good weather conditions in west flow for departures. Mr. Cassady stated the CDA also stated that diagonal Runway 32L, which has been out of service for several months, will be reactivated this November. Mr. Cassady stated this runway was closed for construction activities and as a result of concerns related to converging runway hazards. Mr. Cassady stated this will hopefully create greater distribution of flight traffic.

Trustee Ridder stated the ONCC voted to add another Ward to their Board from the City of Chicago. Trustee Ridder announced that the City of Chicago has ordered eight noise monitors be installed and Trustee Ridder stated the Village of Bensenville has been guaranteed a noise monitor. Trustee Ridder stated she is confident the monitor will be installed by the end of 2014 at Mohawk School. Trustee Ridder stated she has offered Village Staff's assistance to speed the process up.

Trustee Ridder stated the O'Hare Part 150 Noise Compatibility Plan strategy will be discussed at the next ONCC Tech Committee Meeting and that she would report back to the community. Trustee Ridder announced the next ONCC meeting will be held on November 7, 2014 at 8:00 a.m. at 2777 South Manheim Road. Trustee Ridder also announced the next ONCC Tech Committee Meeting will be held on November 18, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. at Mount Prospect's Village Hall (50 South Emerson Street). Trustee Ridder stated both meeting are open to the Public.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Trustee O'Connell made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Janowiak seconded the motion.

All were in favor. Motion carried.

Trustee Ridder adjourned the meeting at 8:22 p.m.
