Minutes:**

The April 19, 2016 Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes were presented.

Motion: President Soto made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Trustee DeSimone seconded the motion.

**Class E1 Liquor
License:**

Village Manager, Evan K. Summers, presented to the Committee an Ordinance Amending Section 3-3-5 of the Bensenville Village Code – Liquor Regulations – to Increase the Number of Class E-1 Liquor Licenses from 6 to 7.

Mr. Summers stated Stella's Place has a pending lease to fill the vacant place within Brentwood Commands.

Ms. Charity Johns, part owner of the proposed Stella's Place, presented to the Committee an overview of the proposed business plan and menu options.

Trustee DeSimone asked if the Village was potentially opening the door for similar businesses to move into Bensenville. Mr. Summers stated each gaming café would require a liquor license which is regulated by the Village Board. Mr. Summers stated each liquor license would be treated on a case by case basis.

Motion: President Soto made a motion to approve this item for placement on a future Village Board Meeting Agenda for action. Trustee DeSimone seconded the motion.

All were in favor. Motion carried.

**Informational
Items:**

Trustee Wessler asked if results were available for the speed-o meter that was placed by Johnson School. Chief Kosman stated he would provide the Village Board with a memo in the Village Manager's Internal Memo.

Trustee Jaworska asked if there was an update regarding a vacant property in town. Chief Kosman stated he has yet to check with the midnight shift and would report back to the Village Board.

Trustee O'Connell asked for an update regarding a Resident's request to install a stop sign at Jefferson and Marion Street.

Consensus from the Committee directed Staff to relocate the stop sign from Jefferson and Park Street to Jefferson and Marion Street. There were no objections from the Committee to place this item on a future Village Board Meeting Agenda for action.

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ADJOURNMENT: Trustee Wessler made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Trustee DeSimone seconded the motion.
