### Simultaneous Petition Filing Lottery Procedures

1. Petitions among new political parties for the same offices or petitions among independent candidates for the same office filed on December 12, 2022 at 8:00 A.M. are deemed filed simultaneously. The names of the new political parties or the names of independent candidates shall be listed alphabetically and shall be numbered consecutively starting with number one which shall be assigned to the party whose name is listed first on the alphabetical list.
2. Petitions among new political parties for the same office(s) or petitions among independent candidates for the same office filed within the last hour of the filing period on December 19, 2022 are deemed filed simultaneously. The names of the new political parties or the names of independent candidates shall be listed alphabetically and shall be numbered consecutively starting with number one which shall be assigned to the party whose name is listed first on the alphabetical list.
3. A simultaneous petition filing lottery is held between new political parties or independent candidates. There is no simultaneous petition filing lottery held between a new political party and an independent candidate.
4. Same sized pieces of white paper shall be numbered, according to the chart below. Each numbered piece of paper shall be folded in half and then folded in half again. Each numbered piece of paper shall be placed in a container and the container shall be thoroughly shaken to mix the numbered pieces of paper.
5. The numbered pieces of paper shall be drawn blindly and at random one at a time from the container. The drawing shall be open to the public.
6. First piece of paper pulled shall determine the first ballot position.
7. Second piece of paper pulled shall determine the second ballot position.
8. Parties shall be certified in the order determined by the procedures outlined above.
