The January 17, 2012 Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes were presented.

Motion: Chairwoman Ridder made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Trustee Peconio seconded the motion.

Wendy Nussbaum,

LPCP Agreement: Police Chief, Frank Kosman, presented to the Committee a resolution authorizing a contract with Wendy Nussbaum, LCPC; Bensenville Teen Center. Chief Kosman stated the proposed contract is increasing from \$4,667.67 per month to \$6,667 per month. The increase is based on an increase of hours per week from 45 to 60. The Green teen Zone will be open an additional hour and a half during the week while school is in session. The increase is also due to an increase of hour opened during the summer.

Trustee Peconio asked if the Green Teen Zone was relocating. Village Manager, Michael Cassady, stated the Village is seeking all options and will report back to the Committee at a later date with a recommendation. Chief Kosman stated the increase is a budgeted item for 2012.
