EI Toreo Liquor License: Police Chief, Frank Kosman, presented to the Committee an ordinance amending the Bensenville Village Code Title 3 – Chapter 3 – Liquor Regulations, 229 West Grand Venue #2W, EI Toreo Market. Chief Kosman stated EI Toreo currently holds a Class F license that allows the sale of packaged beer and wine. EI Toreo has applied for a Class B license which would allow for the sale of packaged spirits along with packaged beer and wine.

Chief Kosman stated Mamma Maria's currently holds a Class E2 license that allows the sale of beer and wine when food is offered. Mamma Maria's has applied for a Class E1 license which would allow for the sale of spirits along with packaged beer and wine when food is offered.
