**A-Lamp Concrete
Change Order:**

Director of Public Works, Joe Caracci, presented to the
Committee a resolution concerning the determination of the
Bensenville Village Board that change order number one
(final) with A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. for an
increase of \$9,564.86 is required for the Volk Brothers
CDGB Project – Phase II for a revised and final contract cost
of \$877,782.86.

Burke Agreement: Director of Public Works, Joe Caracci, presented to the Committee a resolution authorizing the execution of a Design Engineering Services Contract for the White Pines Water Main Replacement Project with Christopher B. Burke Engineering, Ltd. in the amount of \$67,378.

Trustee Bartlett asked what the cost was to the Village in 2008 for a similar study and if any of the information is reusable. Mr. Caracci stated the study was not for the White Pines water mains and a new study would have to be completed. Mr. Caracci stated Christopher B. Burke has a history with the project.

Motion: Trustee Bartlett made a motion to approve this item for placement on a future Village Board Meeting Agenda for action. Trustee Jarecki seconded the motion.

AS SUBMITTED: Chairman Wessler asked for an update on the Village's water loss study. Mr. Caracci presented an update regarding the Village's water loss.

Chairman Wessler asked for an update on the street light on Tioga. Mr. Caracci stated he received an email from ComEd stating the street light will be installed by the end of 2012.

Trustee Ridder asked for an update on the water meter replacement throughout town. Mr. Caracci stated the project will come forth to the Board in January 2013.

Mr. Caracci updated the Committee regarding grants available for electric car charging stations. Mr. Caracci stated this matter will be presented to the Village Board in January 2013.

**INFORMATIONAL
ITEMS:**

Director of Public Works, Joe Caracci, presented to the Committee an overview of the current Residential Overhead Sewer Program. Mr. Caracci recommends making adjustments to the program such as to increase the Villages assistance to 75% of the cost and offer a check valve program.

Trustee Bartlett asked if the Village could add charges to the Resident's water bill to allow payment of the program over a certain time period.

Consensus from the Committee was to move forth with the idea and present to the Village Board at a later date.

ADJOURNMENT: Trustee Bartlett made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Ridder seconded the motion.

All were in favor. Motion carried.
