MINUTES OF THE VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

December 5, 2006

CALL TO ORDER: 1. President Geils called the meeting to order at 7:40 p.m.

District 100 Superintendent, Alf Logan, expressed his delight with the scholarship program and offered his gratitude.

Mr. Wessler offered the Park District's assistance in next year's tree lighting event.
