1. *Public Hearing - Series 2013E \$16,000,000*

*This is the second step in the process to issue \$16 million in bonds for the construction of the new Police Facility at 345 E. Green Street. The Village Board previously passed an Ordinance on July 16 authorizing the issuance of the bonds. This step requires a public hearing prior to selling the bonds. In consultation with our consultant Speer Financial, our plan is to sell \$8 million in bonds on September 10 and the remaining \$8 million in 2014. This method of financing will save the Village 30-40 basis points in the interest rate this year. Also worth noting is the Village plans to sell the bonds in a competitive bid process. In the past the Village has used a negotiated sale process, but due to our improved financial reputation and bond rating we are able to try the competitive process this time around.*

*The property owner of 116 Brookwood requests a text amendment to the C-4 District that would allow outdoor storage as a Conditional Use. Staff opposes this request, which would alter the character desired by the C-4 District, which supports Regional Commercial uses. The CDC unanimously recommended denial of this request at their June 11 meeting, and the CEDC unanimously recommended denial of this request at their June 18 meeting. The item is now before the Board with an Ordinance formally denying the request. The item appears on the Standing Committee agenda since the applicant's attorney has requested an opportunity to speak on the item.*

2. *Ratify Ordinance #56 - 2013, "An Ordinance Approving a Plat of Consolidation at 600 W. Devon Avenue, Bensenville, Illinois", Blu Fuel.*

*This agenda item is a clean-up from the August 20, 2013 meeting. As part of the Blu Fuel Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) fueling station development, a Plat of Consolidation is required. Essentially, the subject property 600 W. Devon Avenue currently exists as two separate tax parcels. By approving this Plat of Consolidation, the parcels are combined into one single lot of record. The Plat was included in the August 20 agenda packet and approved as Ordinance #56-2013, however the Plat was not specifically listed on the actual meeting agenda itself. As such the Village Attorney advises that the Board must "ratify" the Ordinance at this time. Staff recommends approval.*
