For Liquor License

Premises: Deputy Village Clerk, Corey Williamsen, presented to the Committee an Ordinance Amending Title 3, Chapter 3, Section 13 of the Bensenville Village Code to Permit the Retail Sale, Giving Away, and Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor on Class A, Class B, and Class F Licensed Premises Beginning at Nine O'clock (9:00). A.M. on Sundays.

Mr. Williamsen stated Village Staff has received many complaints from holders of Class A, Class B and Class F licenses since the new Jewel/Osco opened in January 2016. Mr. Williamsen stated Jewel/Osco is a holder of a Class H license, which permits the sales of liquor on Sundays beginning at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Williamsen stated Owners have asked Village Staff to present this code amendment to the Village Board to allow their establishments to begin selling liquor on Sundays at 9:00 a.m.

Trustee Wesseler stated he was not opposed to the proposed ordinance amendment, however he would like to remove Class A licenses from the proposal and continue to allow them to sell on Sundays starting at noon.

Consensus from the Committee directed Staff to remove Class A licenses from the proposed ordinance.

Motion: Trustee Wesseler made a motion to approve this item for placement on a future Village Board Meeting Agenda for action as presented. Trustee DeSimone seconded the motion.

All were in favor. Motion carried.
