Qualifications:**

Village Manager, Michael Cassady, presented to the Committee a resolution authorizing changes in Police Officer Qualifications and Appointment Process. The proposed resolutions sets the qualifications as follows: Bachelor's Degree and/or three years of Military experience with honorable discharge and sixty hours of college credit and/or two years of police experience and sixty hours of college credit. Trustee Wessler suggested adding a forth qualification as follows: four years Military experience with a certificate as a M.P. The Committee suggested moving forward with the proposal from Village Staff.
