You must bring the following items:

- Your driver's license, state photo I.D. or other government issued photo ID to prove you are at least 18 years old.
- Your original High School Diploma or G.E.D. equivalent
- \$125.00 non-refundable application fee

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must be able to read, write, and speak English.
2. Must have a High School Diploma or G.E.D. equivalent.
3. Pass an aptitude test
4. Pass a drug screen
5. Pass a physical
6. Pass an agility test
7. Applicants must possess a valid driver's license

Applicants submitting the required documents will be given all the information where and when to appear for the **aptitude test** (See *above to purchase Test-taking tips book), **drug screen** (if applicable), **physical** (if applicable), and **physical agility test** (if applicable). The applicants that pass the minimum requirements of the aptitude test, drug screening, physical and physical agility test will be notified by phone and invited to the oral interviews.
