I am pleased to help you with your March 3, 2017 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Your request was received by the Village of Bensenville on March 3, 2017. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.
