I am pleased to help you with your January 10, 2019 Commercial Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). The Village of Bensenville received your request on January 10, 2019. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

"True North Consultants requests records of public/private water wells within 2,500 feet of Grand County Redevelopment property located at the northwest corner of the intersection of County Line Road and East Grand Avenue in Bensenville, Illinois. The property is located in DuPage County, Illinois T40N R11E Section 25."

After a search of Village files, the following documents are enclosed to fulfill your request:


- 1) Sexton Landfill Plat of Survey. (1 pg.)

These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Per your phone conversation with Director of Public Works, Joe Caracci, the Village of Bensenville is unaware of any current public and/or private water wells within the incorporated limits of the referenced request. He informed you that the area east of County Line Road, south of Grand Avenue and the River Forest Country Club are not within the Village of Bensenville corporate limits and as such the Village does not have information on those areas.

Mr. Carracci was able to find a Plat or Survey from the original construction of the golf course that indicates an old water well on the north side of Grand Avenue. Mr. Carracci assumes that this was abandoned and capped as part of the original hotel site project. The Village did not come across this well at anytime during the construction of the second hotel currently under construction. Mr. Caracci also confirmed that water and sewer connections for the old club house and the maintenance garage were connected to the Village's water system. The old irrigation system consisted of a pump that would draw water from the creek that runs through the property and did not use an irrigation well.
