The Bensenville Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve initial CALEA Accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards. The assessment will take place from Monday, March 4, 2019 through Wednesday, March 6, 2019.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services. The Bensenville Police Department has been accredited with ILEAP since 2015.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session on Tuesday, March 5, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. The session will be conducted in the Village Board Room of the Village Hall, 12 S. Center St., Bensenville, Illinois.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling 630-594-1099 on Tuesday, March 5, 2019, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.

Telephone comments as well as appearances at the public information session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
