Dear Mr. Poulos:

Thank you for writing to the Village of Bensenville ("Village") with your requests for information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.* Your FOIA request provides as follows:

*"The following information regarding the large-scale police incident outlines in Glendale Heights Police Department's October 21, 2021 press release titled "Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm." (1) a complete financial accounting of costs to the Bensenville Police Department regarding the above-referenced police incident."*

The Village does not have an existing public record reflecting a response to your FOIA and is not obligated to create a public record to answer questions posed by FOIA requesters. *See Kenyon v. Garrels*, 184 Ill. App. 3d 28, 33 (4th Dist. 1989).

To be open and transparent, the Village of Bensenville has an Officer assigned to MERIT SWAT. There were no reports generated for this activity, however 8.75 hours of overtime was paid to assist Lombard and Glendale Heights in the same call on October 21, 2021. Again, the Village of Bensenville does not have an existing record to produce responsive to your request.
