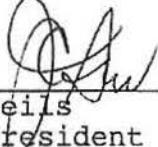
AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bensenville, Counties of DuPage and Cook, Illinois, as follows:

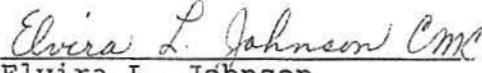

VILLAGE AND FAIRCHILD CONTRACT

This agreement entered into July ²¹, 1992 by and between the Village of Bensenville, a municipal corporation hereinafter called "Village" and Fairchild Printing, Inc. and Burton H. Fairchild and Lenore C. Fairchild individually hereinafter called "Fairchild."

In consideration of the mutual undertaking hereinafter described, the parties agree as follows:

Facade - Parties will divide costs based on plans and specifications attached hereto. Fairchild will contract and supervise reconstruction. Village will pay its share on receipt of waivers on a monthly basis.

Streetscape - Streetscape and landscaping will be on a 50/50 basis. Design by Village, subject to approval of Fairchild.

Lighting shall be by Village.

Parking Lot - Fairchild will convey or cause to be conveyed Lots 14-15 in Block of Tioga PINS 03-14-216-006 and 005.

Village will lease long term (50 years) to Fairchild parking for day shift and Fairchild will provide stickers for restricted parking.

Village, upon conveyance of 2 lots by Fairchild, will design parking facility, install proper stormwater drainage and demolish structure on Lot 15.

Village will pave and stripe parking lot, as well as maintain the same during term of Fairchild lease.

Village will monitor parking as it is needed.

If and when Fairchild expands to the north fifty feet on land presently owned by them, the parking requirements of the Village ordinances shall be deemed satisfied for the existing use.

It is contemplated that substantial performance by both parties shall be completed by September 1, 1992.

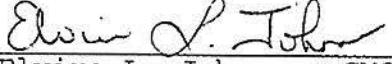

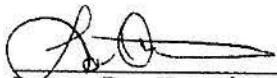

ORDINANCE # 15-96

AUTHORIZING SPECIAL USE PERMIT
FAIRCHILD PRINTING - 14 NORTH CENTER STREET

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bensenville, Counties of DuPage and Cook, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the land legally described as:

OF THAT PART OF LOT 1 LYING SOUTH OF A LINE DRAWN 50 FEET SOUTH OF AND PARALLEL TO THE NORTH LINE OF LOT 1 AND LOTS 2,3 AND 4 IN BLOCK 2 OF THE ORIGINAL SUBDIVISION OF TIOGA, IN THE VILLAGE OF BENSENVILLE, BEING A PART OF THE EAST HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 40 NORTH, RANGE 11, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

Common Address: 14 North Center Street

is hereby granted a special use permit to allow for the expansion of a printing and publishing business in the C-3 zoning district.

SECTION TWO: All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of said conflict.

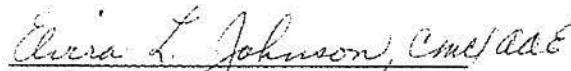
