Dear Mr. Tobias:

I am pleased to help you with your November 1, 2024 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). The Village of Bensenville received your request on November 1, 2024. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

"Requesting building permit #14189 and all underlying documents. This is roof repair at 795 Eagle Dr., Bensenville, IL. I'm insurance adjuster claim for repairs."

After a search of Village files, the following information was found responsive to your request:

- 1) Village of Bensenville Permit Application No. 14189. (17 pgs.)

These are all the records found responsive to your request.

Signatures have been withheld under Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords, or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied with possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: public.access@ilag.gov. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.



Applicable Codes: 2021 International Code sets, 2021 Illinois Energy Conservation Code, and Village of Bensenville Amendments.

Keep in mind as you're removing material from the roof, code section 908.7 now reads when over 50% of the roof is recovered or replaced the roof in its entirety must be replaced.

Plans are approved as noted above





Field view of existing roof membrane






OVERVIEW of ROOF

ROOF REPLACEMENT

TEAR OFF SINGLE PLY MODIFIED BITUMEN PROPOSAL: STORM DAMAGED BLOWN OFF SECTION ONLY: APPROX. 2,400 square feet

- 1) We will completely remove existing roof down to the original roof deck. We will dispose of all debris to an approved waste site.
- 2) We will examine the roof deck and replace any deteriorated decking. Cost of replacement is \$575.00 per metal panel of 12 foot by 3 foot.
- 3) We will then install 2 inch polyiso insulation to bring roof up to existing height with screws and plates. We will then install a base sheet.
- 4) Over this base sheet, we will install a single ply modified bitumen roofing system, using manufacturer's specifications. This membrane is heat-welded to itself to form a water tight seal. We will install breather vents on the roof.
- 5) We will install new 24 gauge galvanized perimeter flashings where necessary. We will caulk the top of metal to assure a water tight seal.
- 6.) We will aluminum coat the roof for additional protection
- 7.) We will secure all necessary permits (fees not included and to be paid by owner).



REPAIR & MAINTENANCE

ROOF REPAIR and MAINTENANCE PROPOSAL: REMAINDER OF ROOF

- 1). We will perform a general inspection of roof to include inspecting all field seams, mechanical curbs, vents, pipe flashing, wall flashings and drains.
- 2). We will repair all openings and deficiencies using manufactures specifications, to include patching with single ply modified bitumen or plastic cement, whichever we deem more appropriate.
- 3). We will reseal all termination metal and caulk where necessary.
- 4). We will reseal all pitch pans where necessary.
- 5). We will clean out drains and gutters where necessary.
- 6). We will then install a heavy fibrated aluminum coating over roof.

This repair carries NO warranty.
