As an initial matter, please be advised that the Village has no existing public records responsive to Part 1 of your FOIA request. The remaining two parts of your FOIA request are hereby granted in part and denied in part as follows. Records responsive to Part 2 of your FOIA request are attached to this correspondence and are being provided to you at no charge. Draft versions of meeting minutes responsive to Part 3 of your FOIA request are being withheld as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA, which exempts from inspection and copying "preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f). The draft minutes in question have not been publicly cited or identified by the Village President.

You have the right to have the partial denial of your FOIA request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You may file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein by reference and made part hereof.


SECTION 2. Jim Stoltman is hereby re-appointed to fill a term of office commencing on May 1, 2023 and ending on April 30, 2026.

SECTION 4. The Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval, as provided by law.



SECTION 4. The Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage and approval, as provided by law.



SECTION 4. The Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage and approval, as provided by law.


