Bensenville, IL - The Village of Bensenville has received a top financial reporting award from the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA), the Distinguished Budget Presentation Award for its 2014 Budget.

"Bensenville's finances have come a long way and we have worked very hard creating and adhering to the highest degree of financial principles and transparency. We do these things because that's what the people of Bensenville deserve and it creates savings and stability." said Village President Frank Soto "These efforts have been recognized by others such as Moody's and Standard and Poor's when they upgraded the Village's bond rating. However, this award is very nice to receive because it is an independent professional entity that reviews and judges budget practices and to win such an award is a great accomplishment for the Village and provides confidence in our efforts to the residents."

The Distinguished Budget Presentation Award reflects the Villages commitment to meeting the highest principals of governmental budgeting. In order to receive this award the Village satisfied nationally recognized guidelines for effective budget presentation.

"Just submitting a budget for review in the budget awards program is a notable achievement. Winning the award is an even greater achievement. The Village of Bensenville should be proud of this accomplishment." said John Fishbein, the Senior Program Manager in charge of the budget awards program with the GFOA.

Award recipients have pioneered efforts to improve the quality of budgeting and provide an excellent example for other governments throughout North America. The Distinguished Budget Presentation Award is the only national awards program in governmental budgeting.

"Bond rating agencies like Standard and Poor's and Moody's look at these awards as evidence that management is following best practices. It is very important that we put in the effort to win them." stated Director of Finance Tim Sloth. "That effort has paid off. Moody's Investors Service has upgraded the Village of Bensenville's General Obligation Unlimited Tax (GOULT) debt rating to Aa3 from A1, which translates into reduced interest costs for the Village."
